



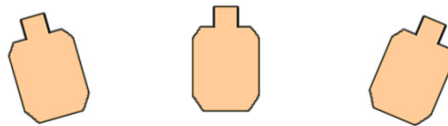

Stage 5 – Body Armor Bandits

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Scenario: You are approaching the bank to make a large deposit when bandits attack. After shooting each one twice, you realize they are wearing body armor. Head shots are what it's gonna take.	
Start Position: Standing at P1 (straddling PVC pipe) facing uprange (PCC downrange) holding money bag in weak hand.	
Firearm Condition: IDPA pistol loaded to division capacity, holstered. PCC held by some part of the rifle other than the pistol grip.	
Procedure: At the signal, engage each threat with at least 2 rounds each and then engage each threat with an additional 2 rounds to the head, WHILE holding the money bag. You may use both hands to reload but all shots must be taken while holding money bag.	
Identify points of cover (PoC) and fault lines: Refer to diagram below and identified in the walkthrough.	
Muzzle Safe Points: Floating 180 degree rule	
Scored Hits: 12	Scoring: Unlimited
SO Notes: Bay 5 Targets: 3 IDPA Targets are 5 yards
