

Stage 3 - At The Garage

RULES: IDPA, April 2005

COURSE DESIGNER: Lee Turner

START POSITION: Pistol, loaded to IDPA capacity, drawn, aimed at the threat (T1)

STAGE PROCEDURE

Scenario: While getting your oil changed at the local garage, a disgruntled customer takes the garage owner hostage and is holding a gun to his head. You have drawn your weapon and are ready to do what you can to save the garage owners life.

Stage Procedure: At the signal from P1, engage the hostage taker (T1) with one round only (no makeup shots). As you exit the garage to summon help, you then notice the hostage takers friends approaching intent on revenge. While using gap between wall and tire stack at P2, engage T2, T3 and T4 with 2 shots to the body and 1 shot to the head in tactical priority. Execute any IDPA approved reload and engage T5 and T6 with 2 to the body and 1 to the head in tactical priority from the right side of the tire stack.

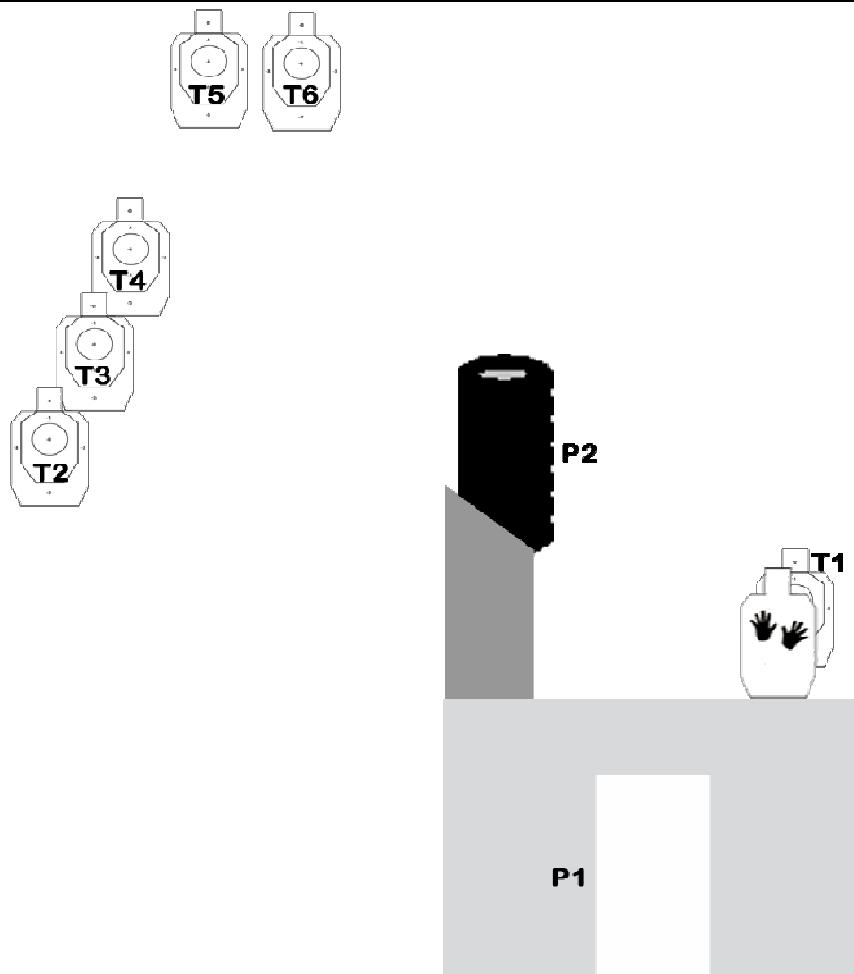
SCORING: Limited Vickers

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: IDPA Scoring

1 No Shoot Targets



SETUP NOTES: T1 is hidden behind NT target as much as possible with only head showing.
